CONVENTION THEME: MADE FOR MORE.

THEME TEXT: Jeremiah 1:7(AMP).

"But the Lord said to me, 'Do not say, "I am [only] a young man," Because everywhere I send you, you shall go, And whatever I command you, you shall speak.'"

BIBLE TEXT: Matthew 6:31-33 (AMP).

Therefore do not worry or be anxious (perpetually uneasy, distracted), saying, 'What are we going to eat?' or 'What are we going to drink?' or 'What are we going to wear?' For the [pagan] Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; [but do not worry,] for your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But first and most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) His kingdom and His righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God], and all these things will be given to you also.

"I alone know the plans I have for you, plans to bring you prosperity and not disaster, plans to bring about the future you hope for."

INTRODUCTION

"Made for more" is not just a positive confession or a prophetic declaration, it's a personal awareness and personal conviction of who God has called us to be individually. From the theme text, there are 5 "you" in that verse to show us that God is primarily

addressing us personally before engaging us as His church. Dear brothers and sisters, I wish to say to you that you are made for more; don't merely seek what to eat, what to wear, fame, power, material possessions, attention, money, marriage, career establishment e.t.c. your life is of more importance to God than all these and if God gives you these things; they are only a means to an end and not an end in itself.
